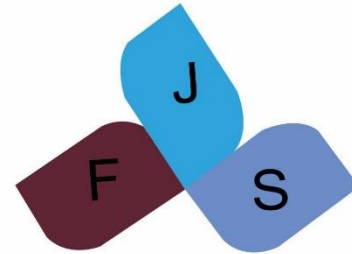


### International Partnerships:

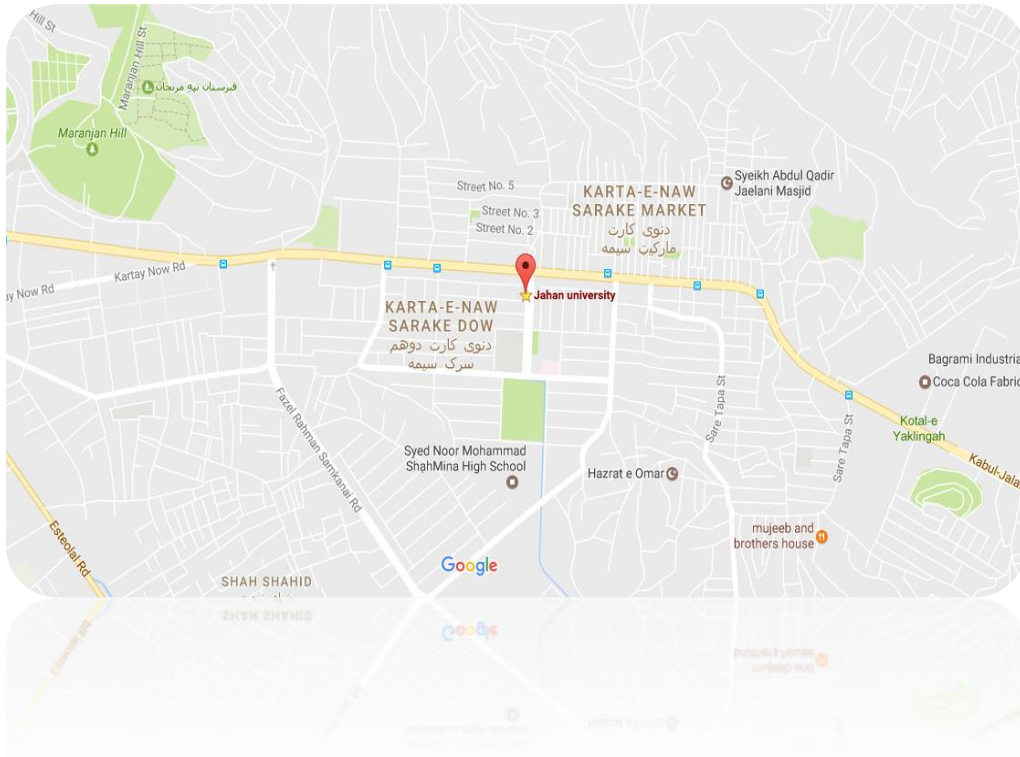
Jahan Financial Services and Jahan Tech are two partners of the university. The former provides professional financial services in various financial fields. The employees in

### Faculty Development Program:

The faculty has a major influence on the entire academic spectrum. The continuing development of the faculty and university's physical infrastructure are two concurrent activities, which go hand in hand in achieving long term objective of the institute, i.e. attainment of highest standards in teaching, learning and research at par with international standards.

The university therefore encourages and supports its faculty to regularly attend workshops/conferences scheduled within the country and abroad.

### Admission Office:

Students who are interested in studying at Jahan University, should fulfill the registration process for entering their desired fields of study. Students should have their registration forms with a hard copy of their other necessary documents and it must be submitted before the end of the registration period. Documents that must be submitted to the Institute, are listed below.

- Registration form ( fulfil )

- Four photos



- 12th grade certificate
- The three-year school marks ( grades tenth , eleventh and twelfth )
- ID card /Tazkera identity card (copy)
- CV ( optional )

After submission of the documents, the office of the university informs the students about the entry exam and the test card will be given to them.

### Scholarships at Jahan University:

Jahan University Scholarship Policy has been framed with the objective to assist students with their educational expenses. The university aims to provide equal opportunity for all students to attain their goals/targets regardless of their financial position. Every year the university allocates funds in their budget plan exclusively for awarding scholarship to the deserving students. Jahan University generously supports deserving students those who perform academically very good but find difficulty to meet educational expenses. Various scholarship schemes are offered to accommodate and honors them through various scholarship

opportunities. The University offers Financial Assistance Scholarship, Merit Scholarship and Advance Merit Scholarship to deserving students from university own sources.

### Types of Scholarships and Their Eligibility Criteria

The eligibility criteria for different types of scholarships are as under:

#### 1. Advance Merit Scholarship For Board Toppers (For Undergraduate Programs)

To ensure that the most talented students join Jahan University, to whom Jahan University offers various financial incentives through university scholarship policy. Under Advance Merit Scholarship Policy, Jahan University shall offer 75% tuition fee waiver/concession for the first semester, to top three toppers amongst all Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education (BISE). This scholarship will be for the entire program. However its continuation during the subsequent semesters will be subject to the condition that awardee must maintain his/her minimum GPA of 3.75.

#### 2. Advance Merit Scholarship (Jahan University Entrance Test based)

Top merit position holders in Jahan University admission merit list with respect to their respective discipline will be awarded scholarships/fee waiver as per following criteria:

##### 1) Undergraduate Programs

For Management Sciences, and Computer Sciences, following three top position

- 1st Position Holder 75% Tuition Fee wavier



- 2<sup>nd</sup> Position Holder 50% Tuition Fee wavier
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Position Holder 30% Tuition Fee wavier

For Law, Computer Sciences, Sharia and political science, one top scorer from each department shall be considered for 75% Tuition fee waiver. The student must obtain an aggregate score of more than 80% in the Jahan University Entrance Merit list.

## 2) Post Graduate Programs

The top scorer in Jahan University Merit List among all Post graduate (MBA/MS/or equivalent) programs excluding PhD for each campus shall be awarded 50% Tuition Fee waiver. The student must obtain an aggregate score of at least 70% in the Jahan University Merit list.

- 3) For continuation of the scholarship in the subsequent semesters for the above categories the students will be required to achieve a GPA of more than 3.85.

## 3. Merit Scholarship:

All students achieving GPA of 4.0 in Semester Examination will be awarded Merit Scholarship equal to 75% of Tuition Fee of the following semester. If there is no student with GPA of 4.0, then the top scorer obtaining a GPA of at least 3.75 will be awarded the Scholarship @ 50% of the Tuition Fee. In case of a tie, the student with the higher percentage will get the Scholarship. In case of a double tie, all students will be awarded the Scholarship.

## Monitoring the Beneficiaries of Scholarships:

The Central Scholarship Committee will formally review cases of all scholarship holders every semester for monitoring academic progress as per scholarship policy. The Committee will submit its recommendations to the Rector for the continuation or otherwise of the scholarship.



The respective Campus Director will send complete semester result of all beneficiaries, to the Central Scholarship Committee. Scholarships of the students, whose performance falls short of the required parameters, may be recommended for discontinuation of the scholarships till the time their grades improve to minimum eligibility criteria as per their respective category.

## General Eligibility for Scholarships:

Eligibility of students for scholarship shall be subject to following conditions:

- a. Students of Jahan University in any semester are eligible, subject to the conditions as indicated with respect to their respective category.
- b. The students have to follow the academic road map with full load.
- c. Students already in receipt of one scholarship/fee concession from university or external resources are ineligible to apply for any other scholarship.
- d. Progress of Financial Assistance, Indigent and all Merit Based

Scholarships will be reviewed every semester.

e. Jahan University Faculty and administrative staff if qualify for merit scholarship will not be considered for award of scholarship. In that case 2<sup>nd</sup> highest shall be awarded.

### Changes in the Policy:

The policy document is subject to changes/amendments from time to time depending upon the future requirements and status of funds available for the grant of scholarship. The new scholarship policy will stand promulgated w.e.f Sept-2015 i.e. Fall-2015. This supersedes all the scholarship policies issued previously.



## 8 STUDENTS SUPPORT FACILITIES:

### The Office of Student Affairs:

The Office of Student Affairs and Career Services at Jahan University is an organized and capable student service resource that is dedicated towards providing support to the students from the draft of policy guideline to ensure its smooth implementation in all campuses relating to Career services, scholarship for students and faculty, Community Support Program, Alumni Affairs, University Advancement and Financial Aid services etc., and to make follow ups on extra- curricular activities being conducted by the student club.

The university believes that it is very important tool to facilitate student life on campus and market Jahan University's students successfully in the business world. As a team, we employ superior resources and techniques to help the students accomplish their goals.

- Providing and distribution of evaluation forms from students' lessons.
- Distribution of clearance form for the settlement of students' accounts of (financial, students, library, documents and departments).
- Survey for students' petition.
- Arrangements of number transcript of students
- Arrangement of announcement, installing them on boards and announce them for students
- Providing inquiry for students to get two year/four years marks
- Holding short term training course for students in English computer etc.
- Collaborating in arrangement and regulating the program before students' graduation.
- Collaboration is issuing and publishing of university's magazine
- Awareness of students for providing video clips for the announcement and

- Publications of university and their active participation in making these clips. Participation in students' council.
- Arrangement of seminars for students
- Providing and arrangement of lectures' attendance sheet
- Collaboration with all departments according to criteria.
- Providing the introduction book of seniors of classes.

### **Career Services:**

Jahan University remains committed in providing not only quality academic services but also offers career services that include employment opportunities, professional grooming and counseling to its students and alumni. The Office of Student Affairs and Career Services keeps on strengthening academic linkages with industry in order to provide the market with our talented and skilled graduates as valuable workforce.

Dedicated staff has been appointed JU Campuses to facilitate students and Alumni in best possible way. A very efficient mechanism is followed where the students and alumni are assisted in choosing the right career paths and inviting market professionals who share their expert opinion and experiences which helps the students in building a deep insight of the corporate world.

Keeping up with the technology pace, all effective means and channels of communication are used for networking with currently enrolled students.

To successfully market our students in the corporate sector, the Career Offices publish a Graduate Profile that is disseminated to all

the leading organizations of the region. Moreover, a Job Expo is organized every year in which various employers are invited to the Campus for recruitment opportunities.

### **Internship program:**

The Academic Vice Chancellor's Office has a mechanism through which the eligible graduate students can apply for the lecturer assistant position. This program is designed for two semesters after which the participant will be appointed as lecturer.

University reserve the right to cancel any program advertised due to insufficient number of applicants.

#### III. Student dropped from Jahan:

Students once dropped from JU on academic grounds, will not be admitted to Jahan University subsequently in the same program.

Those dropped on disciplinary grounds, are not eligible for re admission in any program.

#### IV. How to apply:

Admission to Jahan University are advertised in the leading national dailies, and on Jahan University website [www.jahan.edu.af](http://www.jahan.edu.af) in the month of Jun/Jul and Nov/Dec every year.
